Rules And Other Important Stuff!



TEAMS - Contestants must enter as a two person team consisting of one male and one female or a four person team consisting of two males and two females (maximum four people per boat). Tournament Directors must approve any change in team members after entry is submitted. To be eligible for any prize, all team members must participate for the duration of the tournament (8:30 AM to 2:30 PM) unless approved by Tournament Directors or in the event of an emergency.

ELIGIBILITY - Any applicant under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult partner. Eligibility is at the sole discretion of Tournament Directors and any person or team may be denied entry in the Balls & Chain Tournament for any reason whatsoever at the sole discretion of Tournament Directors.

ENTRY FEE - To encourage early entry (which will aid in our event and dinner planning), the entry fee is \$150 for a two person team or \$300 for a four person team if received by **September 21, 2019**. Entry fees for entries received after the September 15th deadline are \$200 for a two person team and \$400 for a four person team. Teams submitting entries after September 15th will also start the tournament after those teams submitting entries by the deadline.

CASEY'S OPTION POOL - 100% pay out to the two or four person team with a total combined weight closest to 6.25 pounds; \$10 additional entry fee.

TOURNAMENT ENTRY - Entry into the Balls & Chain will be accepted on a first come first serve basis with a maximum entry of 75 boats.

SCORING - Teams may weigh in a total of four (4) fish which will include any / all fish weighed in for any Big Fish prizes. There are no size restrictions for any of the four (4) fish. Any team turning in dead fish will be penalized ½ pound for the first dead fish. Teams turning in two or more dead fish will be disqualified. A dead fish is not eligible for any Big Fish prize.

ALL WEIGH MASTER DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

** Fish weighed in for any Big Fish prize will be added to the team's score-card, released, and will count towards the team's four fish and total weight. Each team may only win one Big Fish prize - either an hourly Big Fish prize or the Biggest Fish of the Day prize. If there are no Big Fish weighed in for an hourly prize, that prize will be awarded at the discretion of Tournament Directors. If there is a tie for any Big Fish prize, the fish weighed in first will be awarded the prize. The official weigh-in time for any Big Fish shall be when the team's boat is docked. **ALL WEIGH MASTER DECISIONS ARE FINAL.***

TOURNAMENT DAY SCHEDULE

6:30 - 7:30 Boat Inspection / Launch / Sign-In

7:45 - 8:25 Contestant meeting and Bribes (All contestants are encouraged to attend but at least one contestant from each team must attend)

8:30 Let's fish!

TOURNAMENT HOURS - Tournament hours are 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM. Start and check in will occur in front of the entrance of the Kettle Falls Marina. Boats arriving after 2:45 PM will be disqualified.

FISHING AREA - Fishing will be allowed within the boundaries of Lake Roosevelt between Grand Coulee Dam and the Canadian Border including all navigable waters that are accessible and open to fishing by Washington regulations. Fishing is not allowed within the boundaries of any marina or within 100' of any net pen.

REGULATIONS - All contestants must observe U.S. Coast Guard, National Park Service and Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife rules and regulations unless specifically waived in these tournament rules. Any contestant cited for federal or state rule violations will be subject to disqualification.

NORTHERN PIKE - Our tournament permit requires we track and report any encounters with Northern Pike including number encountered (caught or seen), approximate size and location. You will be asked for this information at weigh in. Any Northern Pike caught may be kept, killed or immediately released. Any Northern Pike caught are not part of this fishing contest and will not be weighed in.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR INSPECTION - Boats will receive an inspection by Tournament Directors at the Kettle Falls Marina prior to launch; failure to have a boat inspected may lead to disqualification. No boats will have walleye on board prior to the start of the tournament. All boats must meet or exceed State and Federal safety requirements. Washington State requires boat decontamination before launching if your boat has been outside of the State 30 days prior to the tournament date. Washington State regulations require all walleye contestants to have and use an aerated live well.

BOAT IDENTIFICATION: All contestant boats must be clearly identified as such during the tournament.

BOAT OPERATION - Each contestant is required to wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD upon take-off and whenever the boat is being operated at planing speed. Teams will depart only under the direction of Tournament Directors.

POST-TOURNAMENT DINNER - Dinner will be provided for all contestants and will be held at the large building behind TJs Tavern (321 East 3rd Street, Kettle Falls). Social hour will be 3:30 to 4:30 with dinner service starting at 4:30.
